Bay Veterans Foundation, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, was the major partner and fundraising organization of the renovation of Battery Park, as well as the Michigan Gold Star Families Memorial Monument.

The Foundation is now focused on the Bay Area Veterans Makers Space/Learning Center and purchased property at 1009 N Madison, Bay City, in 2018. Upon removal of contaminated soil and asbestos remediation the buildings will be equipped with hand and power tools to be used by veterans transitioning to civilian life and older veterans for recreational therapy.

Bay County has one of the highest per capita concentrations of veterans in the State of Michigan. About 7,300 veterans reside in our communities and a little known fact is over 600 are estimated to be women.

This Space will provide an arena for veterans needing support, camaraderie, more productive use of time, and opportunity to transition back into the community.

A variety of classes, presentations, and information will be made available to veterans. Providers of veterans services will be invited for one-on-one counseling and group presentations.

Our research has been unable to find anything similiar to our Veterans Makers Space project. This could very well be a pilot program and serve as a model for communities across Michigan and throughout the country.
