The Bay Veterans Foundation is currently renovating buildings at 1009 N. Madison, a block north of the Bay County Building. This space will be a Workshop and Learning Center where Veterans can learn (or teach) woodworking, use of CNC machines, laser engravers, etc., in a safe welcoming environment.

We are planning to open Phase I of the project next spring, but looking for individual and community support to raise the final \$100,000. Our Phase I projection was \$710,000, of which we've raised nearly \$600,000. The sooner we can complete the renovation the sooner we can open the Workshop.
